



## Requirements for joining a course:

- Minimum age requirement is 18 Years old (FGASA requirement)
- At LFGA we do not enforce an upper age limit. We encourage students of all ages to become part of our program.
- To complete the NQ all students must be paid up members of FGASA and register for the exam. (The student either registers themselves with FGASA or pays for the optional extra of FGASA registration through us.)
- There are no prior academic requirements in order to complete the national qualification.
- Please note that students are required to provide their own medical insurance while on course.

## Fees and Banking Details

- \* First deposit of 50% is payable a minimum of six weeks in advance to secure place on course.
- \* **NB: The first 50% deposit is non-refundable and serves as a cancellation fee, regardless of timing of deposits and the timing of attendance of the course.**
- \* **2nd deposit (50%) is payable a minimum of two weeks before course commencement. NB: Learners will not be allowed on course and deposit will be forfeited if full payment is not made before course commencement.**
- \* The payment schedule as outlined above is a guideline only. LFGA reserves the right to allocate different payment schedules to any course payments, as circumstances dictate.
- \* Only direct deposits and electronic funds transfers will be accepted. If a cash deposit is received, the student will have to carry the bank cost.
- \* Bank charges on foreign deposits arriving in LFGA bank account must be carried by the depositor.
- \* **If the full amount has been paid, and the student fails to attend the course within one year from start date, the full amount is forfeited.**
- \* **Students who leave the course before it is complete, either by choice or through expulsion will forfeit all course fees.**
- \* Please request a pro-forma invoice from our office when you have selected your course package and are ready to make payment.
- \* NOTE: Any student changing the dates of their attendance of a course phase within six weeks prior to the start of that phase, will be required to pay a 25% surcharge based on the value of that phase. If a student is suspended from course due to disciplinary transgressions and / or breach of the codes of conduct of FGASA, AFGA and / or CATHSSETA, they remain liable for the 25% surcharge, as above.
- \* No students will be allowed onto either phase if they are not fully paid up for that phase.

**NOTE: No deposits are to be made into the company account or the trainer's personal account for pocket money. The student has to have their own bank account for that.**


**NB: No cheques are accepted. Cash deposits carry bank a fee which must be covered by the student. Direct deposits or EFT (internet) are preferred**

## What to bring along (for both the 2 month or 3-4 week courses)

- \* As many reference books as you have (course notes are supplied)
- \* Bring at least 2 pairs of khaki or olive green uniform, for bush excursions. (shirts essential) NO Camouflage (Camo) please.
- \* Binoculars – essential.
- \* Flashlight (Torch) (Headlamp very NB!)
- \* Pens, pencils, exam pad (make sure you write on both sides of your paper!).
- \* “Bush clothes” (neutral coloured clothing) – bright and white do not belong in the bush.
- \* PLEASE ONLY BRING CLOTHING FOR 1 WEEK AS SPACE IS LIMITED. WASHING FACILITIES ARE AVAILABLE.
- \* Something warm to wear, specially in our winter months / also a rain jacket. This is Africa after all...
- \* Walking boots / shoes (plenty of walking)
- \* Water bottle, sunblock, hat.
- \* Soft drinks, snacks etc. (3 Basic meals per day are provided)
- \* Toiletries and Towel
- \* Your own bedding (Sleeping bag and pillow or similar)
- \* Swimming clothes
- \* Insect Repellent
