# ONLINE THEORY COURSE

**NOTE: You can sign up at any stage! (No more waiting for course dates)**

The online theory course is divided into two parts:

1. **Online theory components:** (60 Day duration)

Initial registration (Incl. FGASA E-books, Online Lectures and Theory Assignments)

Once you have completed the theory assignments, you are able to write the FGASA Nature Site Guide NQF2 exam at a national sitting or on site with LFGA at a special sitting.

You will earn a Limpopo Field Guiding Academy NQF2 Theory certificate upon successful completion of the assignments (pass mark = 80%).

In order to achieve the full FGASA Nature Site Guide NQF2 Certificate, you will need to:

- Pass the NQF2 Theory exam (Pass = 75%)
- Attend the 1 Month (minimum) Field Practical
- Pass the NQF2 Practical evaluation.

2. **Practical Contact Course:** (Compulsory for full FGASA Nature Site Guide NQF2 Certificate

Practical contact Course

Covers all practical preparation requirements for FGASA Nature Site Guide NQF2.

Includes the FGASA practical evaluation.

You may only undergo your final practical assessment in the final stages of the 1 Month course, provided you have passed the theory component AND all formative assessments on course.

Once you have successfully completed your practical as well as the theory exam, you will be awarded the FGASA Nature Site Guide NQF2.

**Note:** All theory and practical components must be completed within a period of one year from initial registration in order to successfully complete the full FGASA Nature Site Guide NQF2.

No students will be allowed onto either component if they are not fully paid up for that component.



## **NB!! STUDENTS ON CONTACT COURSE FOR ONLINE THEORY AND FGASA NQF2 PRACTICAL:**

- You have the choice of using your digital copy of the FGASA NQF2 workbook OR to purchase a hard copy set from LFGA.
- You cannot buy the workbook only – or comes in a set of hard copy books – prices available from LFGA office.
- If ordering hard copy books from LFGA, you need to do so before arrival.
- It is an extra fee for the hard copy books, over and above your digital FGASA books that you received on registration.
- The Workbook is needed by your assessor on course when you do the practical evaluation – it needs to be completed in full and submitted at assessment time. Failure to do so will result in your assessment not getting processed.
- Alternatively, you can print out your workbook (and other digital books) before coming on course and bring them with you.
- It remains the responsibility of the student being assessed to submit their completed workbook, either in digital format or in hard copy

NOTE: There are no printing facilities at LFGA – not at camp and not in the office. We work in a paperless online office and do not have printing facilities on site.
